National foreword

This British Standard is the UK implementation of ISO 1722:1999. It supersedes BS 1016-104.1:1991 which is withdrawn.

The main changes from the 1991 edition are as follows:

- the oven previously specified is now given as an example of a suitable oven rather than as a required design;
- the use of nitrogen in the cooling vessel is optional rather than mandatory;
- the reheating time to check constant mass is increased to 30 minutes.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee SFI/3, Analysis and testing of coal and coke, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.
