Foreword

This British Standard was prepared under the direction of the Iron and Steel Standards Committee.

This British Standard is technically equivalent in all aspects except one to Euronorm 163-83 'Delivery conditions for surface finish of hot rolled plates and wide flats' published by the European Coal and Steel Community (ECSC).

The one technical difference is that the requirement limiting the area permitted for repair by grinding is more stringent in this British Standard (see 5.2.2.3). Two appendices, not given in Euronorm 163, are included in this British Standard. These appendices are information to be supplied by the purchaser and a summary of limits specified for surface discontinuities.

Compliance with a British Standard does not of itself confer immunity from legal obligations.
