BS 6566 has been prepared under the direction of the Timber Standards Committee and is in a number of Parts, issued separately. So far eight Parts have been published and Part 9 dealing with strength is in preparation.

Some Sections of BS 6100 are still in preparation and it has been considered appropriate to include, as Part of BS 6566, this glossary which is based on group 2 of BS 6100 : Section 4.3 : 1984 and ISO 2074-1972 published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO).

Where two terms are considered equivalent they are given together in the same type face. Alternative terms are given below the preferred term with their status indicated, e.g. 'deprecated', 'non-preferred'. These terms are not individually numbered, but are included in the index with a reference to the preferred term.
