This Subsection of this Part of BS AU 50, prepared under the direction of the Automobile Standards Policy Committee, is identical with ISO 4250-1 : 1988 'Narrow and wide base off-road tyres and rims — Part 1 : Tyre designation and dimensions' as amended by ISO 4250-1 : 1988/Amd 1 : 1990 and published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO). Subsection 3.2 of the Part deals with tyre loads and inflation pressures. Other Parts of the standard are:

Part 2 Wheels and rims;

Part 3 Valves.

This edition supersedes BS AU 50 : Part 1 : Section 3 : Subsection 3.1 : 1989, which is withdrawn.

Cross-references

The Technical Committee has reviewed the provisions of ISO 4223-1 and ISO 4250-3, to which reference is made in the text, and has decided that they are acceptable for use in conjunction with this standard.
