National Foreword

This British Standard was published under the authority of the Materials and Chemicals Sector Board and comes into effect on 30 September 1994. It is the English language version of EN 23015 : 1992 *Petroleum products - Determination of cloud point*, published by the European Committee for Standardization (CEN), which endorses ISO 3015 : 1992, published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO).

This British Standard supersedes BS 2000 : Part 219 : 1993, which is withdrawn.

This new edition of BS 2000 : Part 219 has been published due to the implementation of ISO 3015 : 1992 as a European Standard. However, there are no other differences between this British Standard and BS 2000 : Part 219 : 1993.

BS 2000 comprises a series of test methods for petroleum and its products that are published by the Institute of Petroleum (IP) and have been accorded the status of a British Standard. Each method should be read in conjunction with the preliminary pages of 'IP Standard methods for analysis and testing of petroleum and related products' which gives details of the BSI/IP agreement for publication of the series, provides general information on safety precautions, sampling and other matters, and lists the methods published as Parts of BS 2000.

The numbering of the Parts of BS 2000 follows that of the corresponding methods published in 'IP Standard methods for analysis and testing of petroleum and related products'. Under the terms of the agreement between BSI and the Institute of Petroleum, the revised version of BS 2000 : Part 219 will be published by the IP (in 'Standard methods for analysis and testing of petroleum and related products' and as a separate publication). BS 2000 : Part 219 : 1994 is thus identical with IP 219/94.

Compliance with a British Standard does not of itself confer immunity from legal obligations.
