This British Standard is the English language version of EN 54-4:1997, including amendments A1:2002 and A2:2006. Together with BS EN 54-2:1997, it supersedes BS 5839-4:1988 which is withdrawn. It is one of a series of standards for fire detection and fire alarm systems (see BS EN 54-1 for a full list of current and proposed standards).

The start and finish of text introduced or altered by amendment is indicated in the text by tags **A1** **A1**. Tags indicating changes to CEN text carry the number of the CEN amendment. For example, text altered by CEN amendment A1 is indicated by **A1** **A1**.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee FSH/12, Fire detection and alarm systems, to Subcommittee FSH/12/3, Control and indicating equipment, which has the responsibility to:
