National foreword

This British Standard is the English language version of EN 60534-6-1:1997. It is identical with IEC 60534-6-1:1997. It partially supersedes BS 5793-6:1986, which is an identical standard to IEC 534-6 published by IEC in 1985. IEC 534-6 will be withdrawn when IEC 60534-6-2 is published at some future date.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee GEL/65, Measurement and control, to Subcommittee GEL/65/2, Elements of systems, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.

A list of organizations represented on this subcommittee can be obtained on request to its secretary.

From 1 January 1997, all IEC publications have the number 60000 added to the old number. For instance, IEC 27-1 has been renumbered as IEC 60027-1. For a period of time during the change over from one numbering system to the other, publications may contain identifiers from both systems.
