This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN ISO 13076:2012. The UK implementation of EN ISO 13076:2012.

BSI, as a member of CEN, is obliged to publish BS EN ISO 13076 as a British Standard. However, attention is drawn to the fact that the UK committee voted against its approval as a standard in CEN and ISO. The UK committee requested specifications in Clause 3 for the test environment and for the apparatus to be used in measuring illuminance. In Clause 4, the UK committee requested additional requirements for the regular assessment of fluorescent lamp performance and for the eyesight of the observer. These elements were not implemented in this document. For this reason, the UK committee submitted a negative vote with respect to this document.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee STI/10, Test methods for paints.
