National foreword

This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN ISO 13120:2013. It supersedes BS EN 14463:2007 which is withdrawn.

The UK committee are committed to the value of a standard representation for distribution of healthcare classifications, and so support the publication of this standard. However, during the development of this standard, the UK committee recommended the adoption of XHTML elements, an evidence-based description of the intended scope of the standard and clarity on the consistent use of the standard for in-scope classifications, but these were not incorporated into the final draft. Implementers wishing to use this standard should contact IST/35 if they have queries regarding its use.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee IST/35, Health informatics.
