This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN ISO 17072-2:2022. It is identical to ISO 17072-2:2022. It supersedes BS EN ISO 17072-2:2019, which is withdrawn.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee TCI/69, Footwear & Leather.

BSI, as a member of CEN, is obliged to publish EN ISO 17072-2:2022 as a British Standard. However, attention is drawn to the fact that during the development of this European Standard, the UK committee voted against its approval.

The UK Technical Committee TCI/69 acknowledges the potential health and safety risks which could be presented by the use of hydrofluoric acid in a commercial laboratory.

In the UK, users who would prefer to use a procedure that uses aluminium (Al) and titanium (Ti) in place of hydrofluoric acid can seek guidance from BS ISO 17072-2:2019.
