This British Standard is the official English language version of EN ISO 4759-1:2000. It is identical with ISO 4759-1:2000. It supersedes BS 6322-1:1982 which is withdrawn.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee FME/9, Bolts, nuts and accessories (+QA and hose clamps), to Subcommittee FME/9/3, Reference standards for fasteners (+tolerance standards), which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.
