National foreword

This British Standard is the English language version of EN ISO 7822:1999. It is identical with ISO 7822:1990. Your attention is brought to the fact that PRI/42 did not support the adoption of ISO 7822: 1990 specifically noting that method B (by disintegration) is not used and is unlikely to be effective for composites. In its reply to CEN, PRI/42 further stated its intention to submit to ISO/TC61 a proposal for the revision of ISO 7822:1990.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee PRI/42, Fibre reinforced thermosetting plastics and prepregs, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.
