Foreword

ISO (the International Organization for Standardization) is a worldwide federation of national standards bodies (ISO member bodies). Together with ISO 11922-1, it cancels and replaces ISO 3606:1976, ISO 3607:1977, ISO 3608:1976 and ISO 3609:1977.
