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BRIEF HISTORY

The ISO Recommendation R 1121, *List of characteristics which may be required of conveyor belts according to their use*, was drawn up by Technical Committee ISO/TC 41, *Pulleys and belts (including V-belts)*, the Secretariat of which is held by the Association Française de Normalisation (AFNOR).

Work on this question led to the adoption of a Draft ISO Recommendation.

In August 1968, this Draft ISO Recommendation (No. 1669) was circulated to all the ISO Member Bodies for enquiry. It was approved, subject to a few modifications of an editorial nature, by the following Member Bodies :
