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BRIEF HISTORY

The ISO Recommendation R 1898, *Phenol, o-cresol, m-cresol, p-cresol, cresylic acid and xyenols for industrial use – Determination of water by the Dean and Stark method*, was drawn up by Technical Committee ISO/TC 47, *Chemistry*, the Secretariat of which is held by the Ente Nazionale Italiano di Unificazione (UNI).

Work on this question led to the adoption of Draft ISO Recommendation No. 1898, which was circulated to all the ISO Member Bodies for enquiry in November 1969. It was approved, subject to a few modifications of an editorial nature, by the following Member Bodies :
