ISO RECOMMENDATION R 267

FIGURES FOR AIRCRAFT INSTRUMENT DIALS
AND NUMBER PLATES

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BRIEF HISTORY

The ISO Recommendation R 267, *Figures for Aircraft Instrument Dials and Number Plates*, was drawn up by Technical Committee ISO/TC 20, *Aircraft*, the Secretariat of which is held by the British Standards Institution (B.S.I.).

Work on this question by the Technical Committee began in 1955 and led, in 1958, to the adoption of a Draft ISO Recommendation.

In May 1960, this Draft ISO Recommendation (No. 367) was circulated to all the ISO Member Bodies for enquiry. It was approved, subject to some modifications of an editorial nature, by the following Member Bodies:

No Member Body opposed the approval of the Draft.

The Draft ISO Recommendation was then submitted by correspondence to the ISO Council, which decided, in August 1962, to accept it as an ISO RECOMMENDATION.
